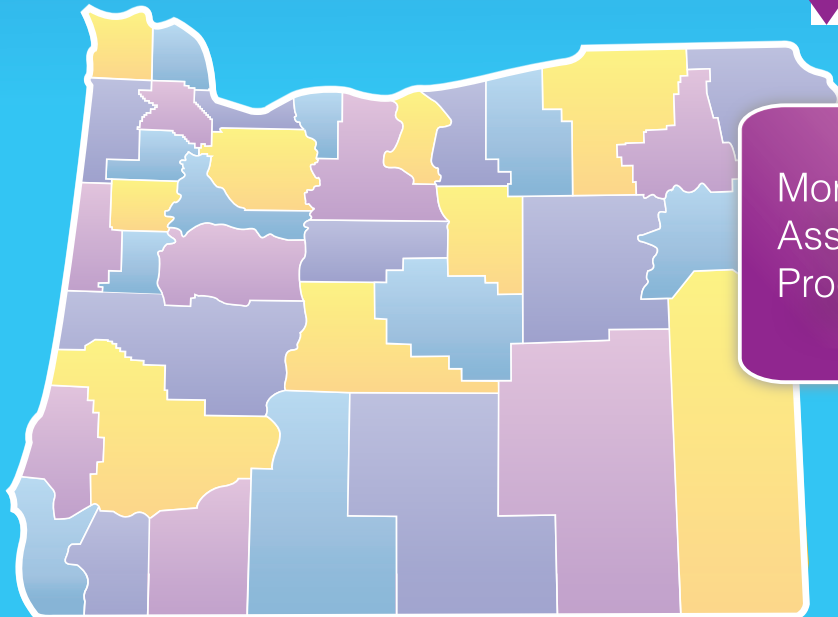

The Mortgage Payment Assistance Unemployment Program (MPA-U) is a new foreclosure prevention program from the Oregon Homeownership Stabilization Initiative (OHSI). MPA-U helps approved homeowners pay their mortgages for up to one year, or for up to \$20,000, whichever comes first. MPA-U is available to qualified homeowners that are currently receiving Unemployment Insurance.

ARE YOU CURRENTLY UNEMPLOYED AND RECEIVING UNEMPLOYMENT INSURANCE?

Program qualifications include, but are not limited to:

- Participant must be receiving Unemployment Insurance at the time of application
- Participant property must be a single-family, detached residence
- Participant property must be a primary residence
- Participant may not be in active bankruptcy
